

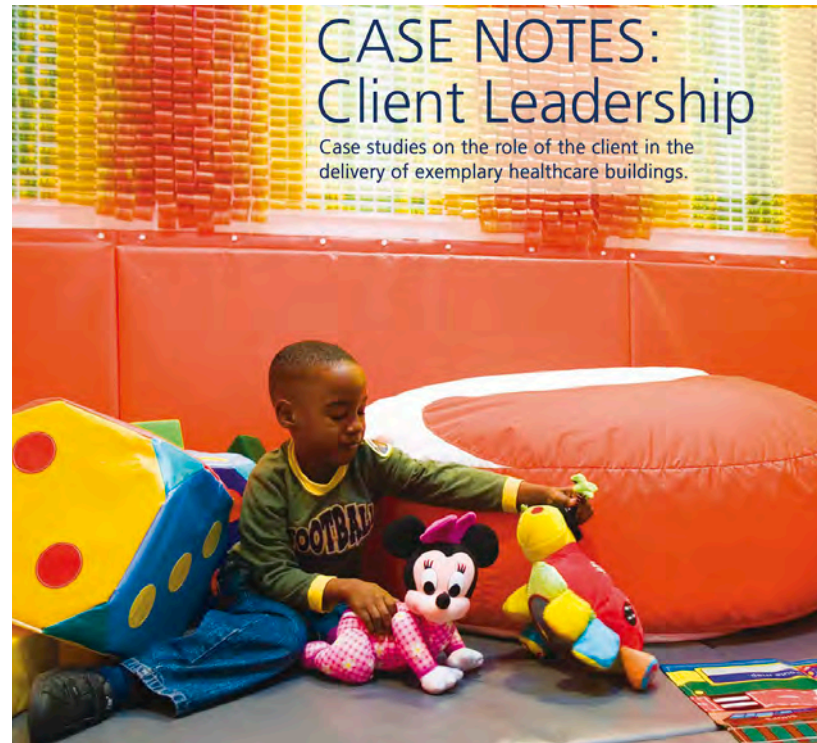
Architecture + Design Scotland

Projects worked on included:

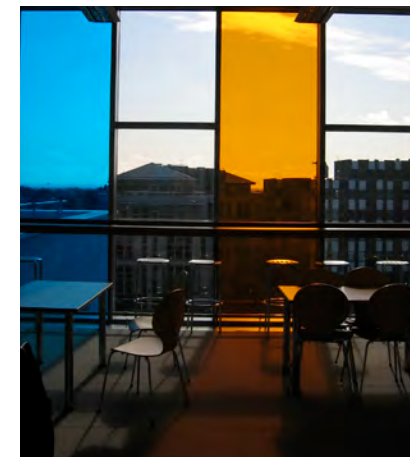
- a review of the Building for Life Programme and its potential applicability in Scotland
